### Selective Admissions Worksheet - Associate Degree Nursing Program Spring 2023

Acceptance into the ADN program is competitive and while published minimum standards may have been met, it does not guarantee admission. The College reserves the right to make changes at any time with respect to course offerings, degree requirements, services provided, cost of attendance e, or any other subject. Students who have met all ADN admission requirements by June 1 will be considered for admission. Admission decisions are made in mid June for the fall semester and students are notified of their acceptance by mail. Students with two nursing course failures (elsewhere, at BCC, or in combination) will not be admitted to the program. **The following criteria are considered in the admissions process:** The number of required science courses completed and grades received; the number of ADN program and general education courses completed and grades received; ADN program prerequisite and corequisite GPA; and completion of additional college degrees. The supporting science courses and chemistry may only be repeated once. All students entering the ADN program must provide proof of immunization n for Hepatitis B (or be in the process) by March 1 prior to the academic year for which they are seeking admission.
